PARK SUPERINTENDENT REPORT Trey Haragan

The parks are in the middle of our maintenance season. We are currently in the middle of going through our Grasshoppers and we will be doing our small engine equipment soon. The parks has received more of the recycled tire grant benches, we received five regular picnic tables and two ADA picnic tables and eight benches. We will be putting two ADA and five regular picnic tables in Laughlin Park and one picnic table at the spring. Two benches on each of the baseball fields and four benches around our U12 and U10 soccer fields. They are all put together and ready to be put out. The Water and Electric Departments installed 14 new sites in the RV Park. They are waiting for the weather to improve to cut the road in and then I believe it will be ready for campers to move in. And then we will be working on cleaning up the bank behind the back in's getting the dead trees out and all of the underbrush out. Then it will be safer to park in the back in's and you will be able to see the creek from the RV Park. On Friday, January 20th we will have 29 volunteers from the Military. We are going to be focusing on cleaning up around the Roubidoux Bridge preparing for the 100th Anniversary of the bridge which will be on April 1st, 2023. No special events scheduled.
