AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 315 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF WAYNESVILLE REGARDING VEHICLE TURNING MOVEMENTS; FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in order to protect the safety and well-being of its citizens, the City of Waynesville recognizes the need to establish restrictions regarding the use of two-way traffic lanes within City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Waynesville amends Chapter 315 of the existing traffic code to include such restrictions for the good of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAYNESVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following section shall be added to Chapter 315 of the City of Waynesville Municipal Traffic Code:

315.040: DESIGNATED TWO-WAY LEFT TURN LANES

Where a special lane for making left turns by drivers proceeding in opposite directions have been indicated by official traffic control devices:

- A. A left turn shall not be made from any other lane.
- B. A vehicle shall not be driven in the lane except when preparing for or making a left turn from or into the roadway or when preparing for or making a U-turn when otherwise permitted by law.
- C. A vehicle shall not be driven in the lane for a distance more than one hundred (100) feet.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage.
